MATERIAL LIST

- *Sketchbook stitched, not spiral bound
- Pigma Micron pens in black or sepia colour (Fine points sizes 005 and 003) and/or
- Copic Multiliner pens in black or grey or sepia colour (fine points)
- Paint brushes *and/or* a waterbrush
- Paper towel
- Coloured pencils in the colours that you normally use and a pencil sharpener, *and/or*
- Watercolour paints and a palette
- Water container (for cleaning your brushes)
- A magnifying lens to help you see plant features if you like focusing on plants
- Ruler
- Scissors
- 2 or 3 glue sticks
- ***Bring with you <u>all</u> those sketches and partly completed drawings and paintings you have in your drawers. Also bring all those sketchbooks that you have lying around where you have used only a few pages to do a sketch or to doodle. The more material you can bring the better and the more fun you will find the workshop.

*Sketchbook. A few important points:

- Your book should be at least an A4 size
- It must have <u>at least</u> 60 sheets, which will give you about 120 pages
- It must be stitched (<u>not</u> spiral bound, because you might want to work across two pages for some of your work)
- The individual page size should be around 15 cm x 21 cm (so when the book is opened, you have a double page measure of roughly 30 x 21 cm).
- Make sure the paper is thick (at least 110 gsm in weight, or heavier) and suitable for pen and watercolour (if the paper is too thin, the pen and paint will bleed through the paper and crinkle it!)
