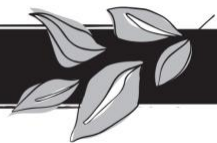

- Permanent markers, biros, fountain pens etc
- Water-soluble markers like Artline 200,
- water-soluble coloured pencils (if you have them)
- Tombow markers in light grey N95 and N75
- Large Pentel Water Brush
- Watercolour tube paints or a travel kit... eg warm and cool of each primary Blue, Yellow, Red plus Sap Green, Naples Yellow (Daniel Smith), Paynes Grey and or a violet/purple of choice.
