## **WONDROUS WATERCOLOUR**

**TUTOR: Ross Paterson**

### **PLEASE BRING**

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Plastic to cover your table
- Water bottle – *its summer and we need to keep up our fluids!*

### **MATERIAL LIST**

#### **Watercolour PAPER:**

- Either Baohong, Saunders Waterford, or Arches 300 gsm. rough—5 sheets.  
Also some cheaper paper for preparation-1 sheet.

#### **Brushes:** (good brands: Escoda, Raphael, DaVinci; or Rekab)

- A couple of round brushes with a good point. (one **large**) eg. **squirrel mop** or sableine or synthetic.
- 1 x large 30-50 ml. flat wash brush.
- 1 x small synthetic
- 1x rigger brush.[small-long hair]

#### **Tube watercolours:** (*Artist quality*)

- Yellows: Raw Sienna, Aureolin, Raw umber, Quinacridone Gold (or Aust. Red-Gold)
- Reds: Permanent Rose, [Or Rose Madder], Light Red, Brown Madder
- Blues: Cobalt Blue, Ultramarine Blue, Cerulean Blue. Cobalt Turquoise Light
- Sepia

#### **Other:**

- Suitable sealed board or *Perspex* to work on (Remember your board will need to be on a slope for gravity-about 20 degrees)
- Pencils / kneadable eraser
- Suitable (open) water container
- Mist Sprayer, fine mist (for water)
- Household sponge – (for mopping your large brush)
- Watercolour Palette -preferably with *deep* wells, and a *big mixing area*
- Masking tape
- a light easel if you have one.

***Participants are encouraged to use their existing materials as well!***
